

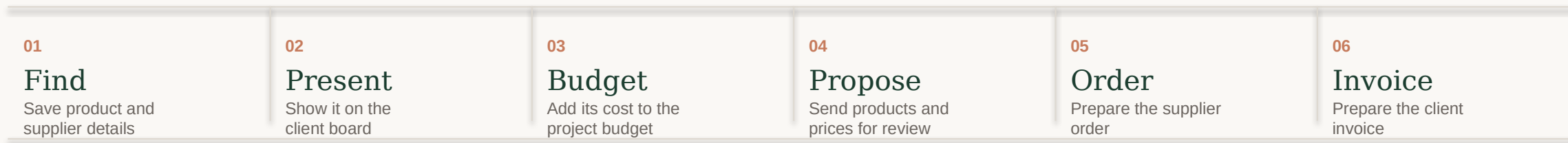
When a client changes a specification, how many documents do you fix by hand?

From a supplier website to your board, budget, and documents.

See a product on a supplier or other website? Use the AI Product Picker to send it straight to your Net Atelier project board, with its image and available product details.

That product populates the project budget. The same current details then feed the proposal, supplier order, and invoice drafts.

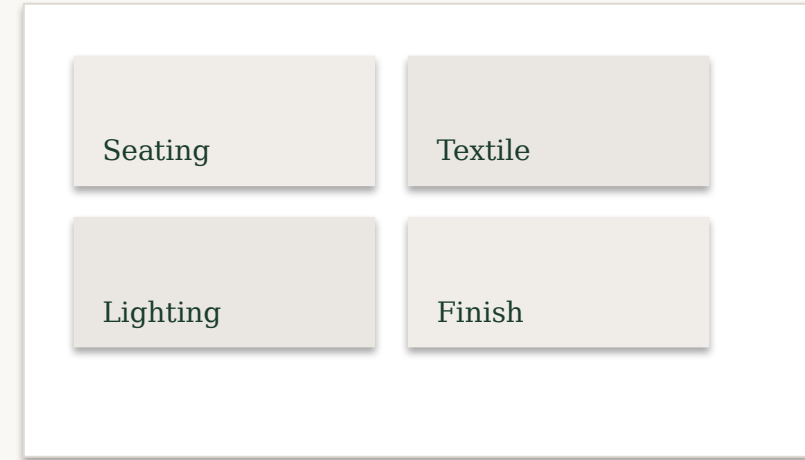

Add the saved product to the board and budget

One product flows into the board, budget, and draft documents

Make the client board part of the working project.

Put saved products on the client board. Each product carries its supplier details and planned cost, so the board is not just a set of images—it is connected to the project budget.

Already have a board in PowerPoint or Canva? Bring it in, then connect the products you want to manage in the project.



Present choices clearly. Keep the related product and budget details with them.

CLEAR CLIENT CHOICES · LESS EMAIL BACK-AND-FORTH

Send a proposal the client can review and respond to.

Create the proposal from the products and planned costs already in the project. The client sees the selected products and prices together, rather than across separate emails and lists.

If the client asks to change a product, update it once, then review the revised draft before you send it.

Make one change—not four separate corrections.

When a client changes a specification, update it once in Net Atelier. The budget and linked draft proposal, supplier order, and invoice use the revised details.

Products and details for the supplier

◆ Invoice

The amount you charge the client

1. Update the changed specification in Net Atelier →

2. Check the revised budget, then review the updated draft before you send it.

Protect the project margin before you place the next supplier order.

Compare the budget with what you have spent

For each category, see the planned cost beside the amount spent. Spot a growing overage before the next supplier order eats into your margin.

Check the total project budget

See the planned total and amount spent for the whole project without rebuilding the totals in another spreadsheet.

Download the budget as an Excel file

Export the project budget when you need to analyse it, share it, or work with it outside Net Atelier.
